

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YFT (YOUTH FOR TOMORROW) QUARTERLY REVIEW PREP

As we gear up for the YFT (Youth for Tomorrow) quarterly review, we want to extend our gratitude to all parents who have submitted their monthly documentation on time. Your diligence is greatly appreciated.

Please remember that the next monthly foster parent documentation is due by September 3, 2024.

To ensure your submission is complete and accurate, kindly follow these steps:

- Review your documentation thoroughly.
- Make sure to align with the agency's philosophy and methods, such as praise, reward systems, token methods, or granting extra device time for progress.
- Include details on:
 - Any serious incidents or major occurrences at home or school.
 - Any abnormal behavior or incidents that compromise the well-being of others.
 - Fights, arguments, or disagreements between foster children or between foster parents and children.
 - Serious incidents requiring immediate intervention.
 - Visits, visitors, and doctor's appointments.

Additionally, thank you for improving your medication logs and addressing any previous issues. Here are some key tips for maintaining accurate medication logs:

- Complete medication logs each time the medication is administered.
- Have the person administering the medication sign the logs.
- Ensure logs reflect the prescribed medication.
- Obtain and submit medication receipts to the case manager.
- Document any changes to medication on the 2043 form.
- Notify the case manager of any medication increases or decreases and get approval from the CPS worker.
- Complete Form 4526 with the physician or their office for changes to psychotropic medications.

We are excited to share that Care Premier Services will be conducting our quarterly YFT review, and we need all monthly documents submitted by September 3, 2024. Thank you for your continued diligence and cooperation.

IMPORTANT REMINDERS

- Attention foster parents: Please use the new monthly notes template, which was implemented on June 20, 2024, for your September 3, 2024, submissions. This update was shared via email from Mrs. Sofia Bayne in June. Thank you!
- 1 Care Premier Services is preparing to launch the Extended Reach software to streamline our documentation and compliance. Foster parents will start using the system by October 2024, with mandatory training sessions to be provided beforehand. We'll keep you updated throughout the process.
